## HTM/ O4 Adventures' STATEMENT OF FAITH

- We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, in their original writing, to be fully inspired by God and accept them as the supreme and final authority for faith and life.
- We believe in one God, eternally existing in three Persons Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of the Father, conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary and is true God and true man.
- We believe that God created man in His own image; that man sinned and thereby incurred
  the penalty of sin, which is death physically and spiritually and that all human beings inherited
  a sinful nature.
- We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for the sins of humanity as a substitutionary sacrifice according to the Scriptures and that all who believe in Him are justified on the grounds of His shed blood.
- We believe in the bodily resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, His ascension into Heaven, and His present life as our High Priest and Advocate.
- We believe in the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- We believe that all that repent of their sin and receive the Lord Jesus Christ by faith are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God.
- We believe in the present day presence of the Holy Spirit, empowering and equipping believers for service, with gifts, fellowship and divinely ordained ministries.
- We believe in the resurrection of both the just and the unjust, the eternal blessedness of the redeemed, and the eternal banishment of those who have rejected the offer of salvation.
- We believe that the one true Church is the whole company of those who have been redeemed by Jesus Christ and regenerated by the Holy Spirit; that this church is the community of believers, which consist as the Body of Christ on earth.
- We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ appointed ordinances Two of which LCF highlights.
   Baptism with water and the Lord's Supper, which is to be observed symbolically as, acts of obedience and as perpetual witnesses to the cardinal facts of the Christian faith.
